GREETING

Kake Educational Institution currently governs eight affiliated schools that include three 4-year universities (Okayama University of Science, Kurashiki University of Science and the Arts, and Chiba Institute of Science) a junior/senior high school, and vocational schools, making it the largest educational institution in western Japan. Each school strives to pursue its own unique education and research under the founding philosophy, 'To draw out each and every youth's abilities to their maximum potential, and to educate individuals to contribute to society as skilled professionals and as members of their communities'.

Furthermore, Kake has aimed to develop personnel who can contribute on a global scale, offering various international exchange programs since the late 1970's, having signed educational agreements with 71 schools of higher education in 22 countries. Active recruitment of international students has also been a major project, resulting in over 800 students currently enrolled from many parts of the world.

This pamphlet explains details of the wide range of studies offered at our three universities.

Many of the studies directly relate to future employment opportunities, and the Career/ Global Centers of the three universities, together with the Department for International Affairs can act as intermediaries for employment at Japanese companies in your home countries as well as support applications for work visas once employment is confirmed.

Kake has also held international Japanese speech contests since 2011. This international exchange event holds the purpose of spreading Japanese language and understanding of Japanese culture. Regional contests take place from summer to fall of each year, the final held in Japan in late November. Please contact the local office in charge of the Kake International Japanese Speech Contest if you are interested.

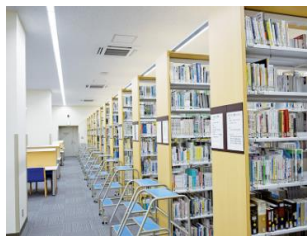


Conceptual drawing

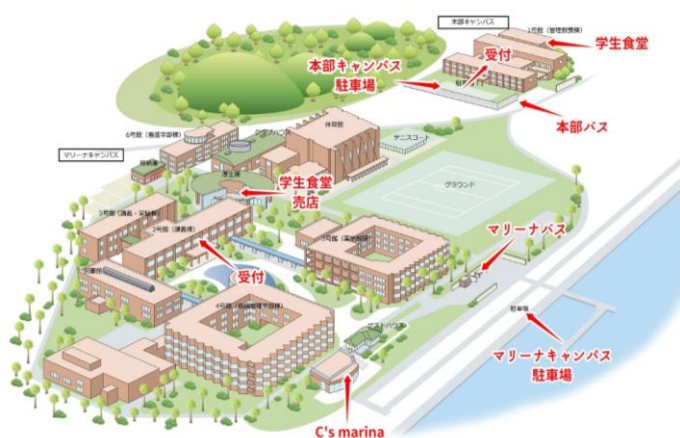

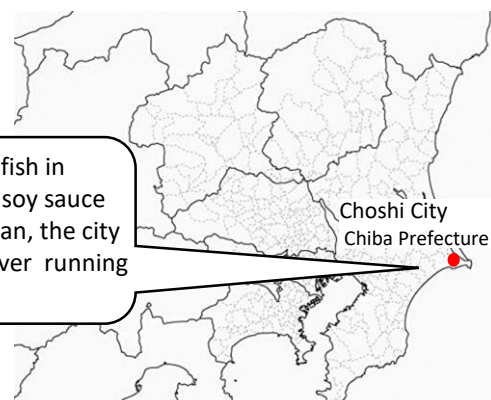

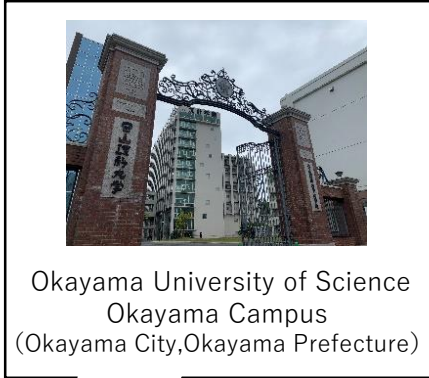
Location of 3 Kake Universities

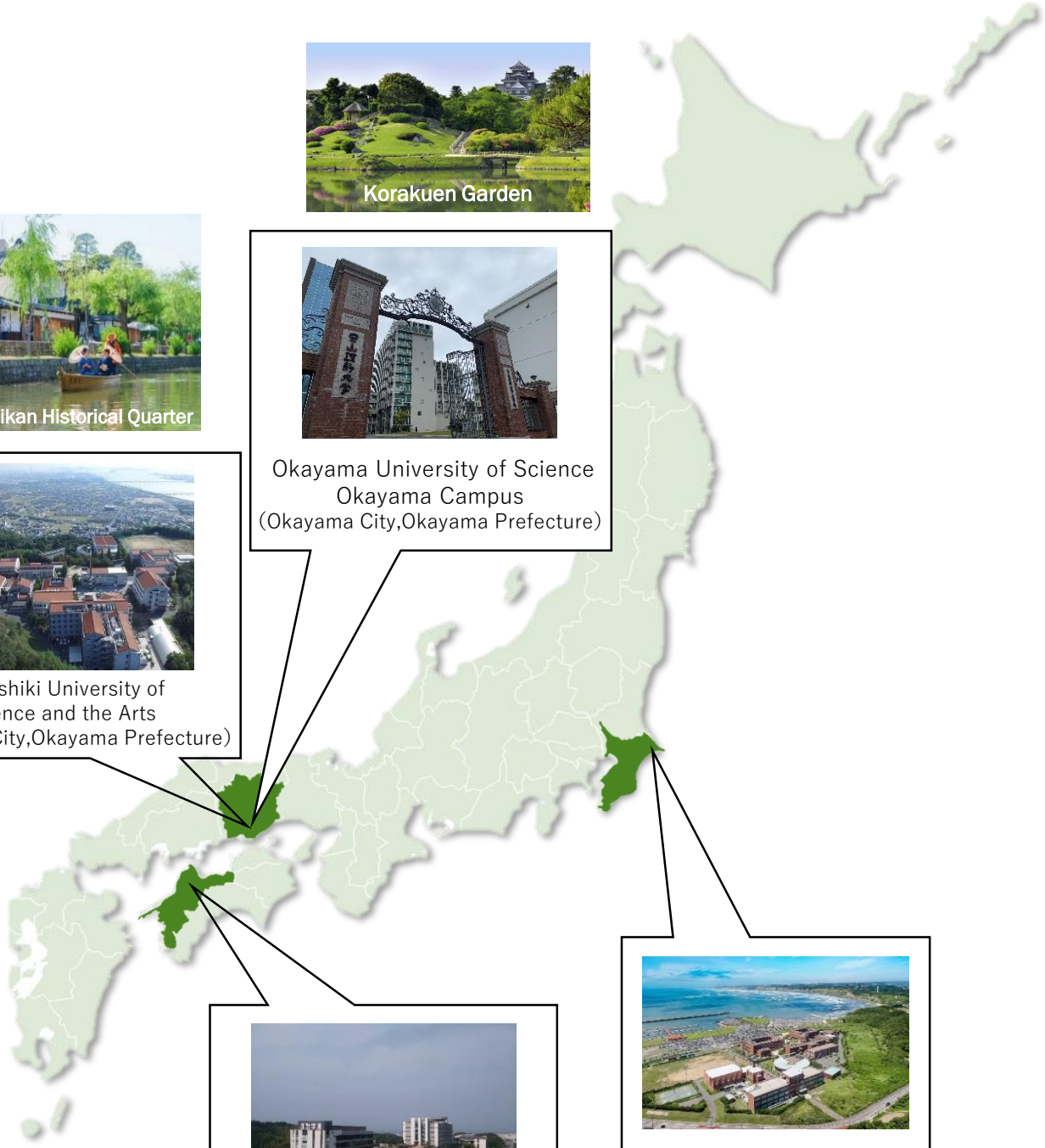

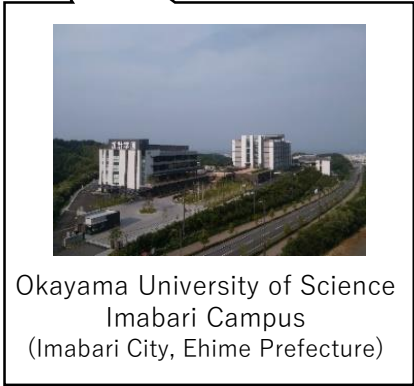

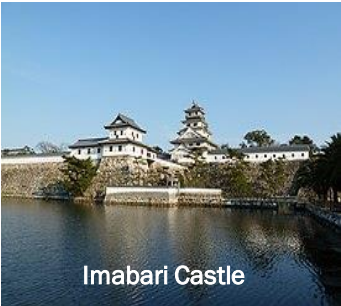
